



America's Clogging Hall of Fame Honor Teams Qualification Requirements

as of June 2026

Age requirement as of JANUARY 1ST per competition year

- Junior All-American Team (age 9-15)
- All American Team (age 16-49)
- Senior All-American Team (age 50 & over)

Directors who have competed with ACHF for at least three years can submit nominations each year to the ACHF Honor Team committee. A director can submit their nominations during their third qualifying year. The nominee must be present to accept their jacket and certificate and must be competing with their team at ACHF nationals to receive this honor. A director is allowed to nominate two dancers for Junior All American and two dancers for All American. There is no limit to the number of Senior All American submissions. Nominations do not guarantee a spot on the All American team.

Qualifying expectations for Honor teams:

- Encouraging, Driven, and Enthusiastic
- Exhibits leadership characteristics such as a Team Captain. Promotes team spirit at all times. Is dedicated and committed to his/her team
- Demonstrates exceptional attendance traits, to include practices, competitions, and other scheduled events set forth by the team Director
- Displays a, "Results, Not Excuses" attitude at all times
- Always has a positive attitude, willingness to learn, help others, and exhibits a genuine love for clogging
- Demonstrates positive sportsmanship amongst teammates and toward other teams when participating at events
- Displays good character within the ACHF organization, and always positively promotes the ACHF brand on and off the dance floor
- A nominee has been affiliated with ACHF for 3 consecutive years.
- Dancer must have danced with the director's team for one full ACHF calendar year.
- A Dancer can not be considered for the All American team if they were just nominated for the Junior All American team. It must have been 2 years since they joined the Junior All American team.

Only submissions from directors will be reviewed and considered by the Honor committee. The Honor committee reserves the right to select dancers who they deem worthy of this designation. The Honor team selection process of nominees is handled between the Honor committee and the ACHF Executive board.

Special Honor Teams: Any special honor team such as Team of the Decade, etc., will be nominated by the Vice-Presidents of ACHF Executive Board and submitted to the ACHF board for review. The Honor committee will contact the directors or a family member for information on receiving an award. The ACHF Executive Board will vote on the selection of dancers to be presented for the Special Honor teams.

Maximum number of dancers per honor team:

- Junior All American Team.... 24
- All American Team.... 24
- Senior All American Team... No limit (Not enough each year to set a maximum)
- Team of the Decade... 24
